TEAM Passionate about Art Day

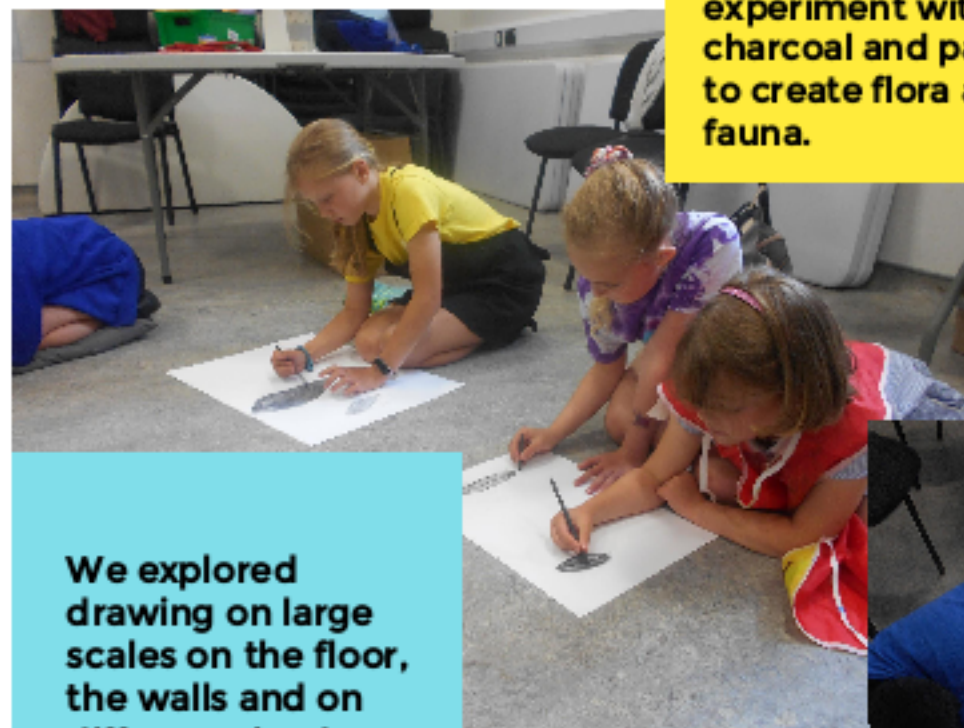


The morning session focus was drawing. The children were taught how to experiment with charcoal and pastels to create flora and fauna.

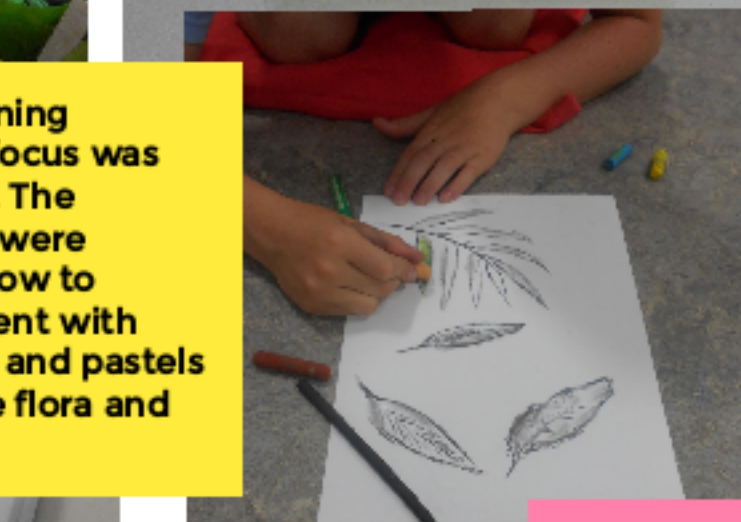


We studied jungle art created by the artist Henri Rousseau.

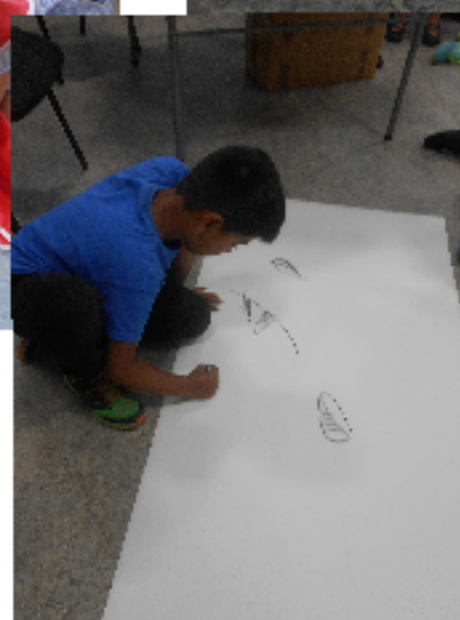
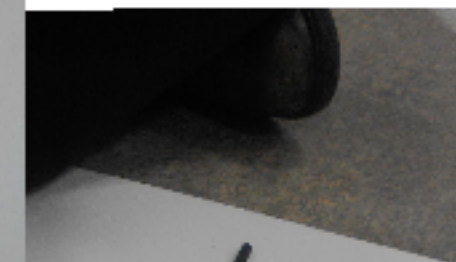
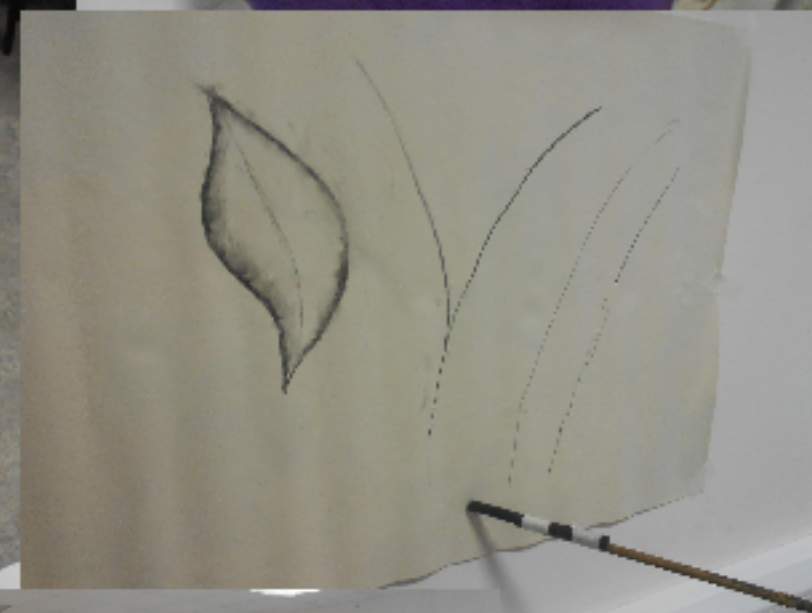
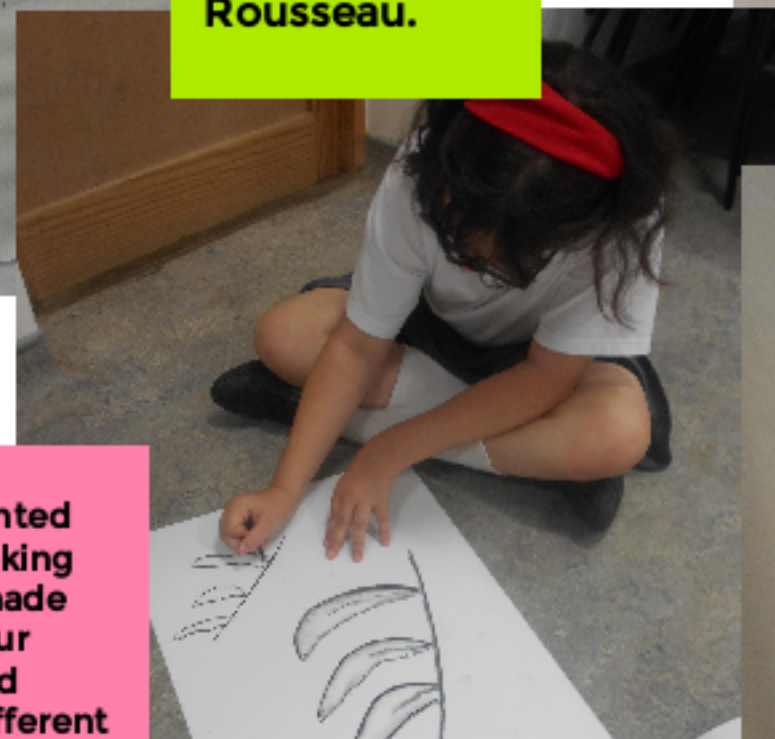
We even attached the charcoal to a bamboo cane so we could create long sweeping lines.

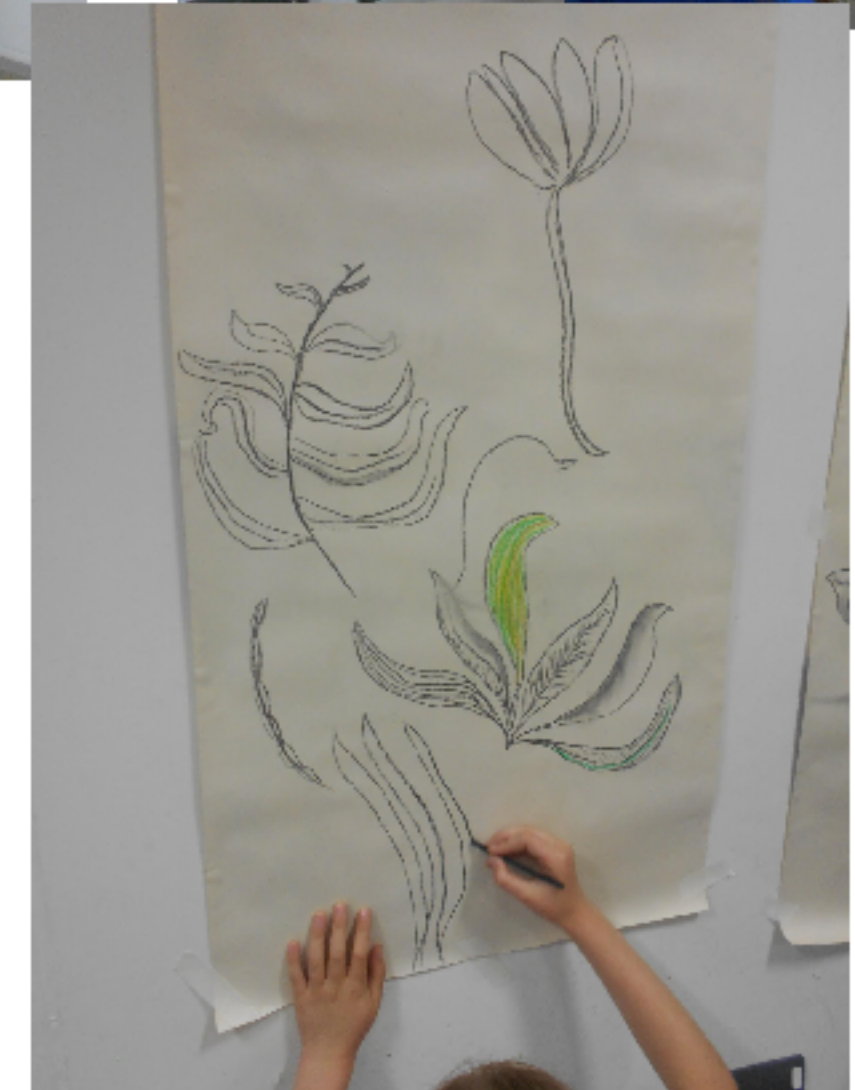
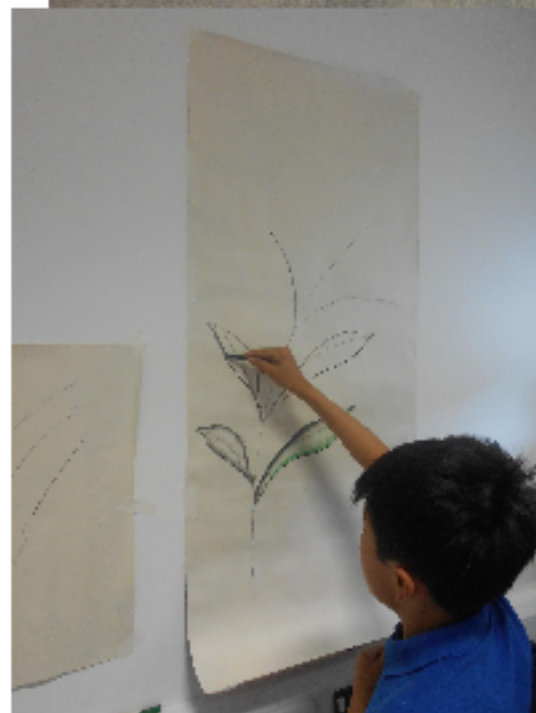
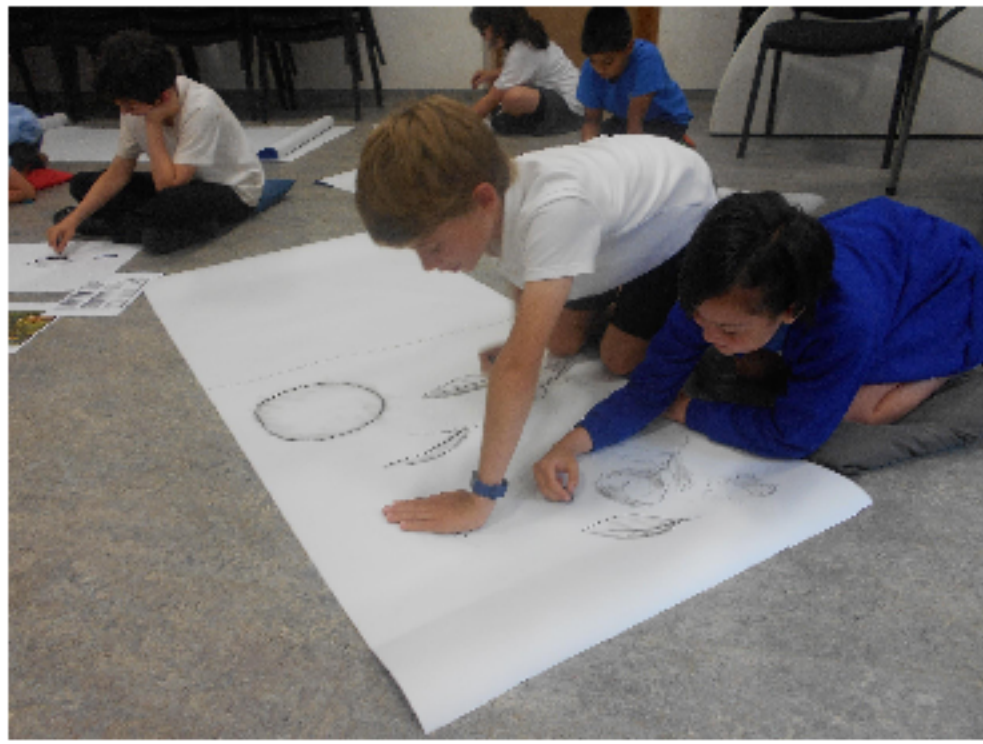


We explored drawing on large scales on the floor, the walls and on different sized pieces of paper.



We experimented with mark making to add line, shade and tone to our work. We used charcoal in different ways to try out different effects.





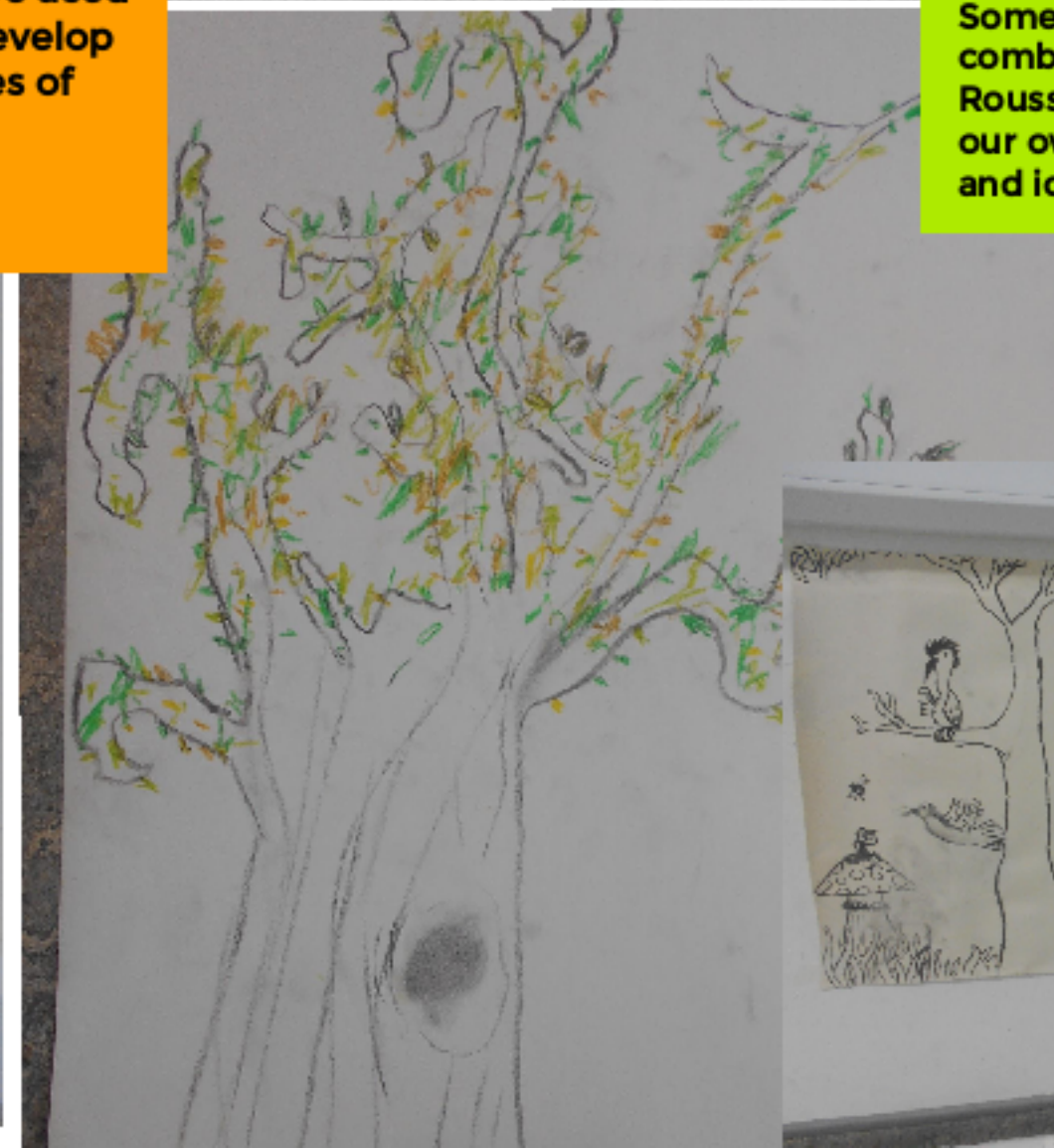
Experimenting with

We chose our favourite techniques from the morning in our final pieces. Some of us combined Henri Rousseau's art with our own interests and ideas.

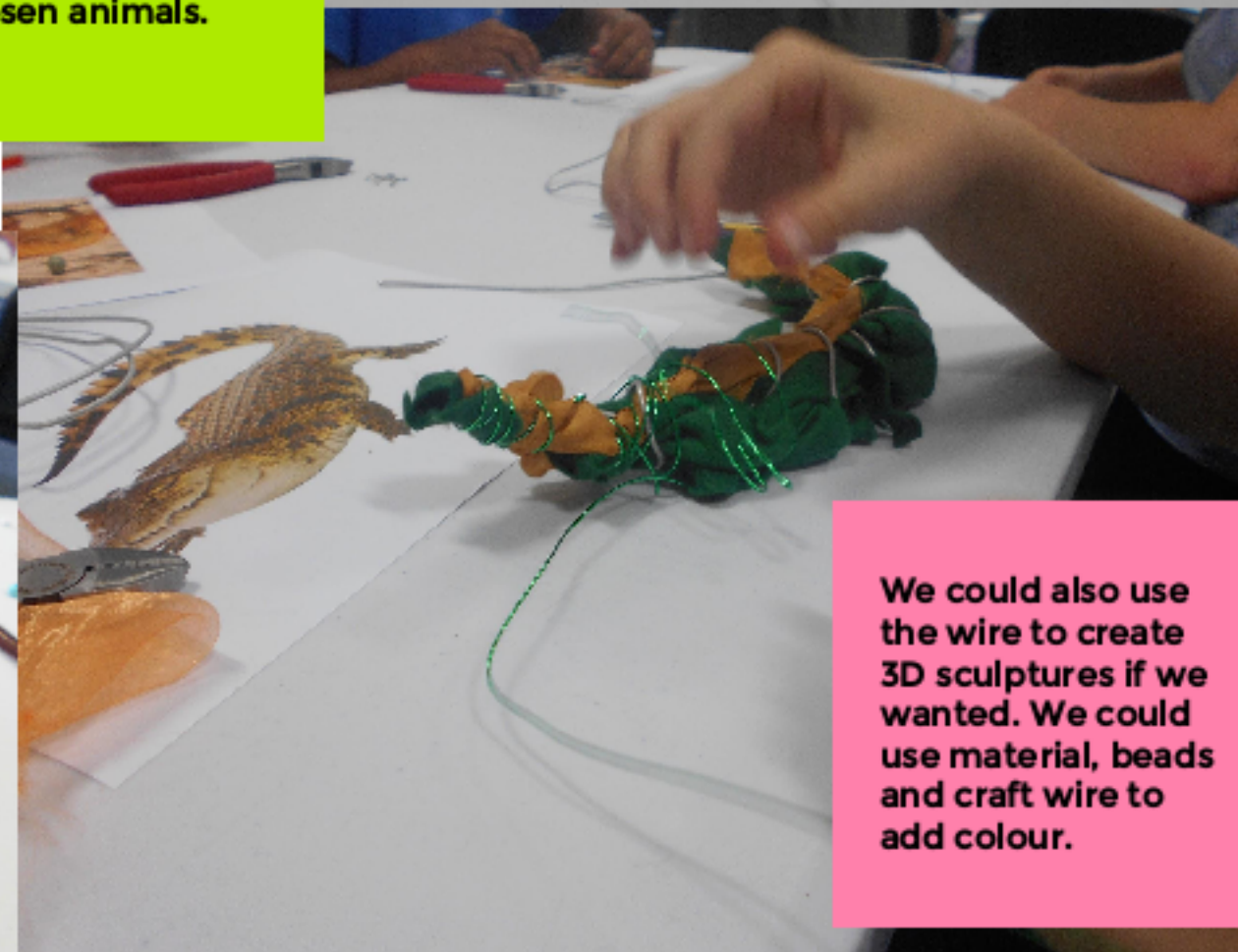




The afternoon session focused on sculpture. We learnt about a wire sculptor called Alexander Calder. We looked at how we could link his ideas to Henri Rousseau.
