If you forget it, then please arrange to drop one off at the school office by morning break.

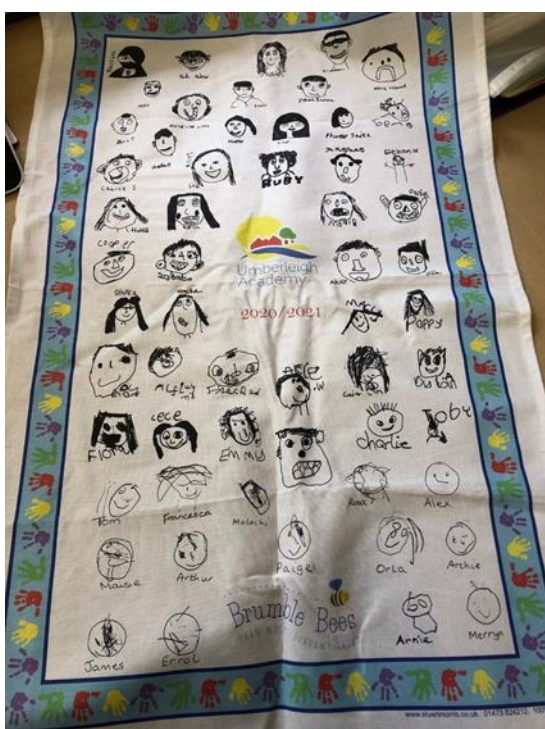
