(weather permitting/ we do have gazebos so all should be fine)

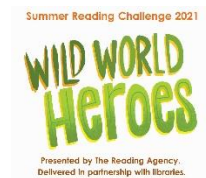
Village Hall team supply 4 gas BBQ's (One for vegetarian choices)

Go wild for reading with the Summer Reading Challenge!

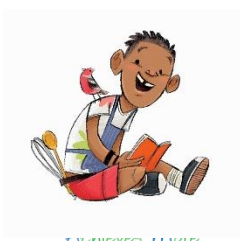
