

# Umberleigh School Pupil Premium Provision Map 2016/17

The pupil premium is additional monies given to schools to support pupils who are considered disadvantaged. The chosen measure for this is the entitlement of Free School Meals within the past 6 years. The current funding is approximately £10,010 in total. Estimated costs have been allocated in the following way.

**Blue = Enrichment/engagement**

**Yellow = Well-being**

## Interventions

**Overview:** provision of TA time to deliver intervention programmes to support children

Cost £6,130

**Aim/outcomes:**

To accelerate rates of progress in all subjects across all year group divided equally between KS1/EYFS and KS2. Additional focus on younger children.



## Gifted & Talented Workshops

**Overview:** provision of external workshops to extend more able pupils

Cost £ 300

**Aim/outcomes:**

Increased confidence

Enable more able children to access wider opportunities

Increased attainment in related subject i.e. Maths, Writing, Science.

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## Additional resources

**Overview:** To provide additional resources as needed to ensure full integration i.e. smaller tables & Chairs & specialized cutlery for lunchtimes.

**Cost:** £1,000

### Aim/Outcomes:

Ability to share lunchtimes with peers to ensure social interaction at this important time and to encourage essential skills.

## Breakfast/Afterschool Care

**Overview:** Free places for enable parent to attend meetings and school functions

**Cost:** £ 250

### Aim/Outcomes:

Increased attendance at key meetings such as curriculum sessions and parent teacher meetings



## Creation of Friendship Groups

**Overview:** To provide a special space for children experiencing challenges and facilitating sessions to allow discussion.

**Cost** £400

### Aim/Outcomes:

Friendship space seen by teachers and pupils as a safe area for talking, group work and meetings.

## Uniform Provision

**Overview:** School Uniform provided for those in most need

**Cost:** £80

### Aim/Outcomes:

To promote a sense of well-being and belonging to the school community through quality uniform provision

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## Extra-Curricular – Music Lessons

**Overview:** Monies available to support children in learning a musical instrument

**Cost** £ 300

**Aims/outcomes:** To provide an opportunity and equal access to learn an musical instrument

## Forest School/Funfit

**Overview:** Monies available to facilitate additional sessions to support children in their social engagement in a practical context.

**Cost** £400

**Aims/outcomes:** To provide practical and physical learning where children work in groups and develop their social skills.



## Subsidised Trips

**Overview:** School trips and residential subsidised to ensure access for all pupils

**Cost** £650

**Aim/Outcomes:**

Raise aspiration, motivation and engagement.  
Secure equal opportunity.

## Swimming Lessons

**Overview:** Pupils have the opportunity to learn to swim and develop water confidence.

**Cost:** £ 500

**Aim/Outcomes:**

- Increase self-esteem; improve motorskills, increase skill and social confidence.
